**Interested in a volunteer opportunity?** Volunteer Services provides a variety of programs for Department of Health and Human Services clients. There's a program for everybody ranging from a long-term commitment to a one-time donation.

**Current volunteer opportunities:**

The goal of the **THANKSGIVING FOOD BASKET PROGRAM** is to ensure that families in need have a more meaningful holiday. Volunteers can donate and deliver a food basket individually, or coordinate a food basket drive for several families. Cash donations are also accepted.

**CHAIN (Communities Helping Adults In their Neighborhood) REACTION** is a program that volunteers work in groups of 4-6 to do raking, window washing and light yard work. This is usually done on a Saturday in April and October. Volunteers can coordinate a group or sign up individually to be assigned to a team.

Around certain holidays, such as Christmas and Easter, individuals or groups call to make a **HOLIDAY DONATION** or inquire about **ADOPT-A-FAMILY**. In these cases Volunteer Services will find a family that would be a good match for the donor.
